Top Teams Entering Lady Seminole Golf

A first annual Lady Seminole Golf Tournament will have at least 10 teams competing Monday and Tuesday here.

Six of last year's first 10 finishers in the Association for Intercollegiate Athletics for W o m e n (AIAW) National Championships will be on hand — including the top three teams.

"This is an outstanding field for a first tournament," said Lady Seminole Golf Coach Sylvia Ferdon, "and it is an indication of just how much the women's golf teams are looking for fall tournaments.

"We hope to fill part of that void by making the Lady Seminole a regular event every year at this time. By getting it established now while women's intercollegiates is still in formative stages, we could have one of the country's top tournaments."

"This is an outstanding field for a first tournament," said Lady Seminole Golf Coach Sylvia Ferdon, "and it is an indication of just how much the women's golf teams are looking for fall tournaments.

"We hope to fill part of that void by making the Lady Seminole a regular event every year at this time. By getting it established now while women's intercollegiates is still in formative stages, we could have one of the country's top tournaments."

Among the teams which will be competing are Rollins, Miami and Furman — who placed one, two, three in the AIAW Nationals last spring. Other top 10 finishers from that competition who will be on hand are Florida (5th), Miami-Dade North JC (8th) and Auburn (10th). Rounding out the field are Florida International, Alabama, Pensacola JC and the Lady Seminoles.

The 36-hole tournament will be played in two days, with the low four scores of each day counting toward the team title. Each team will be allowed to enter five players.

An individual champion will be decided on medal - play basis.

Competing for Coach Ferdon's Lady Seminoles are senior Denise Bisset from Jacksonville, junior Cindy Hilty from Lake City, sophomores G a y l e Lee from Perry and Becky Baker from St. Louis, Mo. and freshman Laura Rusk from Orlando.

Rego Leading Seminole Golf With 73 Total

Brenda Rego, a freshman from Hawaii, fired a consistent one-over-par 73 Monday to lead her Miami Dade North teammates into the first round lead of the Lady Seminole Golf Tournament at the Seminole Golf Course.

The Falconettes finished the first day with a team total of 308 to take a 12 stroke lead of the University of Florida Gators.

The 10 competing teams will play the final 18 holes of the 36-hole tournament today.

The Lady Gators led a pack of four teams fighting for second place honors. Alabama is third at 323, followed by Rollins at 324 and the University of Miami at 327.

Florida State's Lady Seminoles, paced by Cindy Hilty's 84, were seventh with a 346 total, 11 strokes behind sixth place Furman.

Marth Jones of Alabama had a 75 and Rollins' Terri Thoreson and Dade North's Dale Lundquist shot 76s to challenge Rego for the lead.
