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FSU WIN RYDER/WOMEN'S FLORIDA INTERCOLLEGIATE GOLF TITLE

Florida State, which entered the day with a narrow three-shot lead over Miami, held on to edge the host Hurricanes for the team title at the Ryder/Women's Florida Intercollegiate Golf Championship at Don Shula's Golf Resort in Miami Lakes. Both Florida State and Miami shot 305 for the final round, giving FSU a three-day total of 898 and Miami 901.

Sue Veasey of South Florida, which finished third at 916, won the individual title with a 217, two shots better than Miami's Kim Augusta. Both shot three-over par scores of 75 today. The day's best round was shot by FIU's Moira Dunn, who had an even par 72 and finished tied for ninth at 228.

Florida State's win, its first in the 22-year history of the Women's State Intercollegiate, broke a three-year winning streak by the University of Florida. The Gators finished fifth at 932.

The three-day tournament was held at the 6070 yard, par 72 Don Shula's Golf Resort at Miami Lakes.
