WOMEN'S GOLF TEAM FINISHES FOURTH AT ACC'S, PASCUAL DEL POBIL MAKES A COMEBACK IN FINAL ROUND

GREENSBORO, NC--The Florida State women's golf team remained in fourth place through the final round of the ACC Championships on Sunday. The Lady Seminoles shot a 314 in the third round to give them a 944 for the tournament. Final scores were quite spread out as Duke took home the team title with an 891, while Wake Forest finished second with a 899. North Carolina placed third with a 925.

Senior Mabel Pascual del Pobil shot a one-over par 73 in the third round, just one stroke off the individual champion Jenny Chuasiriporn of Duke. Her final round showing moved her from last place 20th, where she had been since the first round, up to 14th. Her finish was the highest for the Lady Seminoles, and was the seventh tournament this season where she led the team.

The women's golf team has concluded their regular season, and will know the status of their NCAA Tournament play later this month.
