The FSU's women's golf team teed off their 1995 fall season at home with the annual Lady Seminole Invitational held at Seminole Golf Course. Defending champion Louisiana State reappeared in strong fashion, again taking the team title with a 22-stroke lead over second-place Florida State. Mabel Pascual del Pobil overcame a first-round 82 to shoot a 74 and even-par 73 in the final 36 holes and finish in 7th place. Her final round 73 was the low score for that day. Kate Burton also made the top ten, finishing just one stroke off Pascual del Pobil. Angie Stafford of South Alabama took home the individual title while three LSU players finished in the top five.
