FLORIDA STATE FINISHES STRONG AT BRYAN NATIONAL COLLEGIATE WOMEN'S GOLF TOURNAMENT

BROWN SUMMIT, N.C. -- Florida State sophomore Kristin Tamulis shot a season-low 71 and finished in a tie for 28th-place as four Seminoles shot below, at or one stroke-over par in the final round of the Bryan National Collegiate Women's Golf Tournament at the Bryan Park Champions Golf Course in final round action Sunday. The Seminoles shot a season-best 289 round as a team and finished in eighth place in the team standings. Florida State's eighth-place finish in the final standings represented a six-position jump over the final two rounds of the tournament.

Tamulis (Naples, Fla.) shot her best round of the tournament, one-under par 71, in Sunday's final round. She totaled a 223 three-round score and finished in a tie for 28th-place in the event. Tamulis's score of 223 was the third lowest tournament score of her 17-event career at Florida State.

Freshman Alison Curdt (Ellisville, Mo.) shot a career-best even-par score of 72 and finished in a tie for 46th-place. Her previous best round as a member of the Seminole women's golf team was a four-over par 76 during two events in the fall of 2000. Curdt was in a tie for 73rd-place after the first round and finished in a tie for 46th-place -- an improvement of 27 places.

Senior Louise Wright (Ipswich, England) continued her consistency as she carded a one-over par 73 in Sunday's final round. She totaled a 223 and finished in a tie for 20th-place. Junior Kelley Henderson (Marietta, Ga.) shot a career-low one-over par 73 and finished with a career-low tournament score of 235.

Florida State finished third among the five Atlantic Coast Conference teams who participated in the event. No. 1-Duke won the team title with a tournament record score of 856 and No. 22-ranked Wake Forest finished second with a score of 879. The Seminoles, ranked 43rd-in the nation, finished ahead of No. 40-ranked North Carolina (ninth place) and No. 2-ranked South Carolina (13th-place). Candy Hannemann of Duke won the individual title with a score seven-under par score of 209.
