FLORIDA STATE WOMEN'S SOCCER

FSU DROPS ACC OPENER 3-1 TO 9TH RANKED VIRGINIA

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- The Florida State women's soccer team (2-1) lost their ACC opener 3-1 to No. 9 Virginia (3-1) despite a great defensive performance, holding the Cavaliers to a 13-6 shots on goal advantage. Last year UVa outshot the Seminoles 28-0 in Charlottesville.

UVa's Dina Padula led off the scoring when she struck in a loose ball from 18 yards out at the 18:27 mark.

FSU answered right back twenty-six seconds later when sophomore forward Alexandra Osorio knocked in her first goal of the season, a cross pass from freshman midfielder Kasey McCall. This also marks the third straight game McCall has had either a goal or assist.

UVa's Angela Hucles finished the scoring for the Cavaliers with two unassisted goals, the first coming at the 35th minute mark and the second was in the 62nd minute mark.

FSU freshman midfielder Leslie Del Rio suffered a dislocated collar bone in the 79th minute on a tackle.
