FLORIDA STATE SCORES BIG WIN OVER GEORGIA STATE

ATLANTA, GA -- The Florida State women's soccer team (9-3-1), led by senior midfielder Kelley Poole, broke a 1-1 tie in the 83rd minute and defeated Georgia State 2-1 at GSU's Panthersville. FSU pulled out their seventh road win on Poole's goal from five yards out in front, assisted by Nicole Sedgwick.

FSU first scored on freshman forward Angela Bonaffino's shot from 13-yards out early in the second half. The Panthers tied the match in the 81st minute on midfielder Kara Fitzgerald's goal from the left side.

Poole, a transfer from Simon Fraser University in British Columbia, Canada, currently leads the team in goals scored (11) and has six in the last four matches.

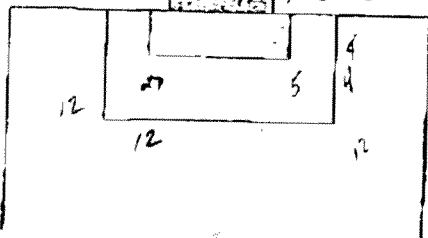

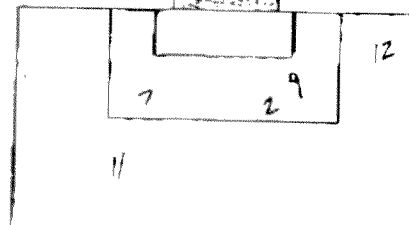
