FSU DEFEATS #10 CLEMSON 1-0 FOR 1ST ACC WIN

Tallahassee, FL -- The Florida State women's soccer team (11-4-1) shut out 10th-ranked Clemson (11-4-1) 1-0, before a crowd of 363 at the Seminole Intramural Soccer Complex. The win was both the first win over an ACC team in school history, and the first win over a ranked opponent.

In a game marked by defensive play, Florida State prevailed when Lauren Lynch knocked in a loose ball off the post in the 68th minute.

Melissa Juhl recorded her eighth shutout of the year, and first over an ACC school.


The Seminoles next game is a home match against the sixth ranked Florida Gators Wednesday, October 23.


