FSU LOSES TO WAKE FOREST IN FINAL HOME GAME

Tallahassee, FL -- In the final game of the regular season, the Florida State women's soccer team (12-6-1, 2-5 ACC) dropped a heartbreaker to Wake Forest (12-6, 2-5 ACC) 1-0 at the Seminole Intramural Soccer Complex.

Despite numerous scoring opportunities and outshooting the Demon Deacons 18-8, the Lady Seminoles gave up the game's only score in the 11th minute when WFU's Norine Fernbach knocked in teammate Rachel Thomas' shot that had deflected off of FSU goalkeeper Melissa Juhl.

The Seminole's second season was highlighted by wins over 10th-ranked Clemson and 12th-ranked N.C. State. FSU finished up their home season with a 6-4 mark at the SISC, with a record attendance of 1,123 against Florida.

The loss to Wake Forest puts the Tribe into a tie with Wake Forest for 7th place in the final ACC regular season standings. FSU will most likely have the eighth seed in the ACC tournament against top-seeded North Carolina, starting Thursday, November 7, in Greenville, SC.

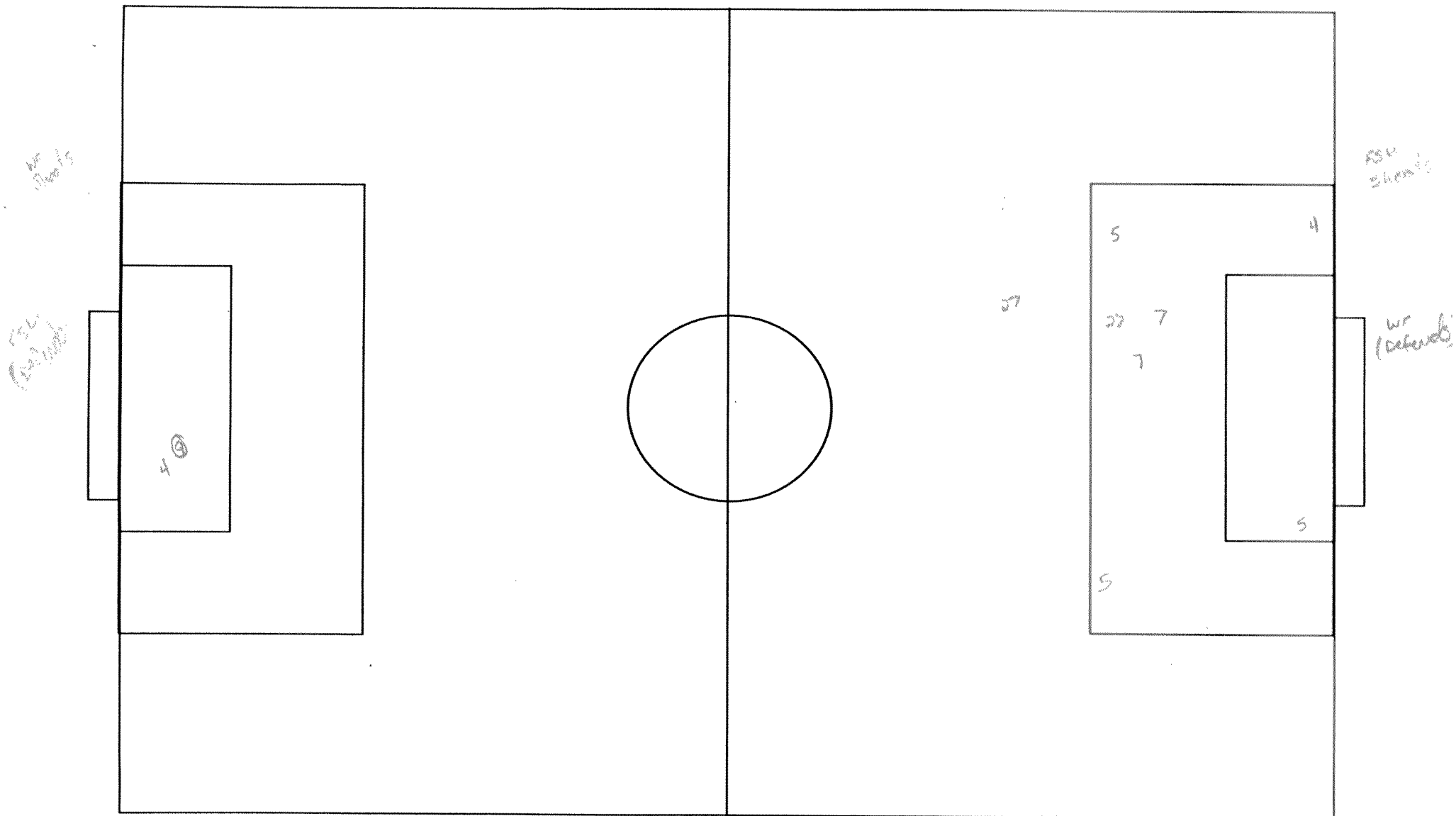
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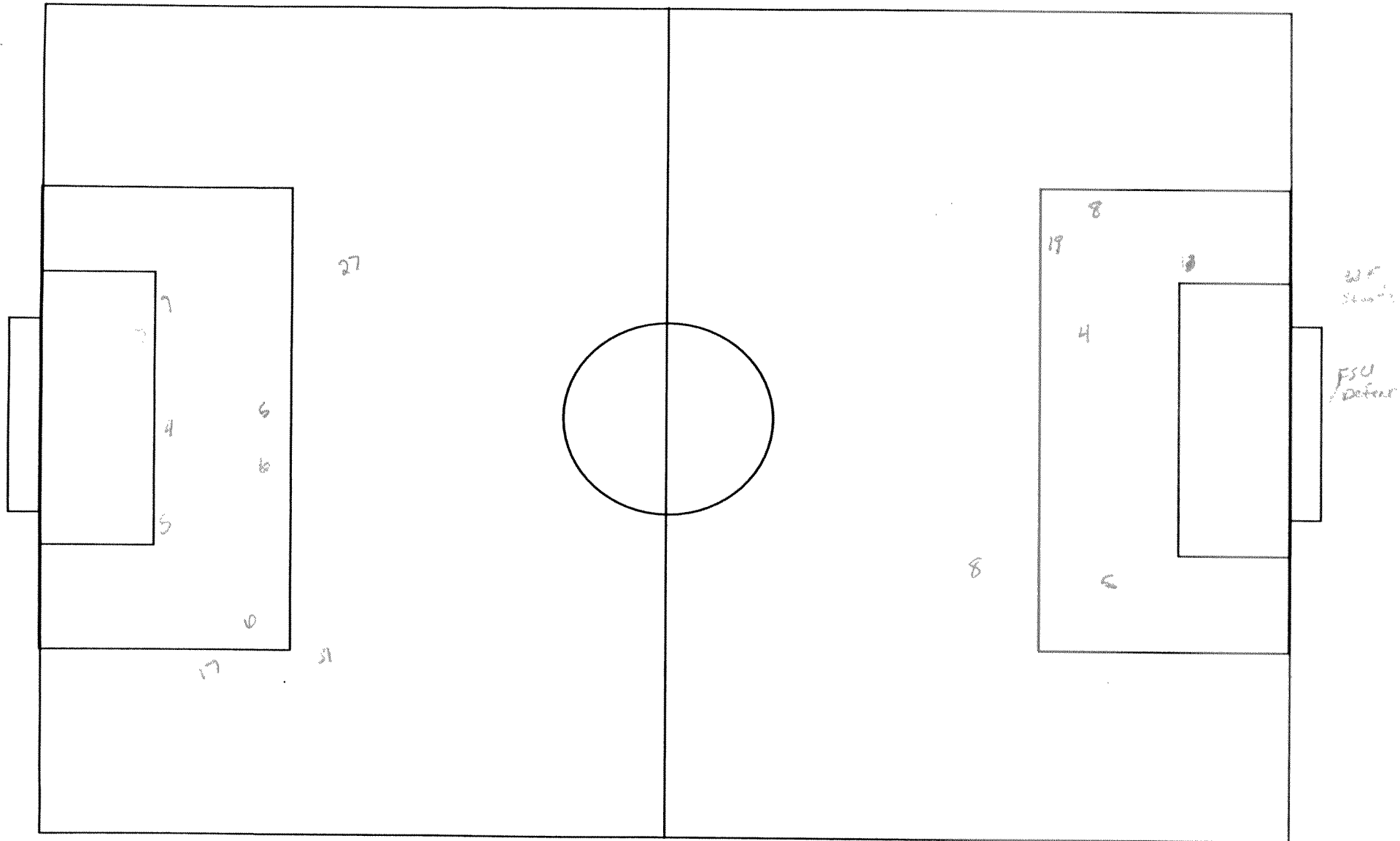
