FLORIDA STATE SOCCER FALLS TO GEORGIA

ATHENS, GA -- The Florida State women's soccer team lost its first match of the season this afternoon as #16 Georgia defeated the Seminoles 2-0 in the championship game of the Nike Classic. Syracuse defeated Central Florida in the consolation match 5-1 in Athens.

Georgia scored their first goal three minutes into the match and scored again at the 10:00 mark. The Seminole defense held Georgia to the two goals but never scored. Senior Alex Osorio led the Seminoles with four of their nine shots.

The Seminoles are now 2-1 on the season. FSU returns to action on Friday as they host Virginia, their first ACC matchup of the season at 7:00pm.

*A shot is an attempt that is taken with the intent of scoring and is directed toward the goal. Note: A cross is not a shot. A cross is a long kick from a wide position into the penalty area in front of the goal. The intent of a cross is to set up a scoring opportunity for an attacking player. A goalkeeper who intercepts a cross is not credited with a save. To receive a save, the goalkeeper must have stopped a ball that otherwise would have gone into the goal. Each shot results in one of five possibilities: a goal, a save, it hits the post, it is blocked by a defender, or it is high or wide.
