FSU SOCCER TIES IN DOUBLE OVERTIME

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Florida State women's soccer took South Florida into double overtime tonight and held them to a 1-1 tie at the site of the Seminole Soccer Complex. The Seminoles are now 4-7-2 as the Bulls go to 9-0-1.

"I'm very pleased with the way we played tonight," Head Coach Heather Kerby-Nelson said. "We had our best performance of the season tonight. If (April) Murphy's shot had been a few inches lower, we would have won in overtime."

The Seminoles held South Florida until the 44:50 mark in the first half when USF's Carlene Wawrzonek scored off a cross from Siri Nordby. Florida State scored off a corner kick at the 80:00 mark that hit the goal keeper and rolled off a defender into the goal.

FSU continues play tomorrow at home against Jacksonville at 7pm.

*A shot is an attempt that is taken with the intent of scoring and is directed toward the goal. Note: A cross is not a shot. A cross is a long kick from a wide position into the penalty area in front of the goal. The intent of a cross is to set up a scoring opportunity for an attacking player. A goalkeeper who intercepts a cross is not credited with a save. To receive a save, the goalkeeper must have stopped a ball that otherwise would have gone into the goal. Each shot results in one of five possibilities: a goal, a save, it hits the post, it is blocked by a defender, or it is high or wide.
