FLORIDA STATE SOCCER TIES NC STATE (Seminoles continue unbeaten streak at home)

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- The Florida State soccer team took the NC State Wolfpack to double overtime tonight, ending the game in a 2-2 tie at the Seminole Soccer Complex. The Seminoles are 8-7-1 on the season as the Wolfpack goes to 6-7-2.

"I was disappointed with getting a two goal lead in the first half and not being able to get that third goal," Head Coach Patrick Baker said. "A 2-0 lead is a good start but we needed to play 90 minutes and stressed that at half time. We needed to get that third goal and we lost focus."

Sophomore Marte Vik Edvardsen took a short cross from her sister Maren to score the Seminoles first goal at the 5:20 mark. Junior April Murphy added another goal off a short cross from Maren Vik Edvardsen to give FSU the 2-0 lead at the half. NC State's Shannon Blair put the Wolfpack on the board with a goal off a direct kick from 35-yards out at the 50:00 mark before tying the game with another direct kick at the 67:53 mark to send the game into overtime. The two teams remained scoreless after two sudden death overtime sessions and finished the game at 2-2. Maren Vik Edvardsen led the team with two assists and three shots.

"I have to take my hat off to Shannon Blair for two incredible goals," Baker said. "Those were just two unbelievable goals."

"We've been stressing to the freshman how not only are we fighting the 11 players on the other side of the field but we are also fighting history. We've only won three games in the ACC since the program began and they need to understand what we're fighting here. They played a tough first half and I was proud of them for going out strong in the first half. We just need to start playing a full 90 minutes."

The Seminoles return to the field on Sunday, October 24 at 1:00pm. Florida State will host the Duke Blue Devils live on the Sunshine Network.

*A shot is an attempt that is taken with the intent of scoring and is directed toward the goal. Note: A cross is not a shot. A cross is a long kick from a wide position into the penalty area in front of the goal. The intent of a cross is to set up a scoring opportunity for an attacking player. A goalkeeper who intercepts a cross is not credited with a save. To receive a save, the goalkeeper must have stopped a ball that otherwise would have gone into the goal. Each shot results in one of five possibilities: a goal, a save, it hits the post, it is blocked by a defender, or it is high or wide.
