SEMINOLE SOCCER SETS RECORD IN 3-0 OVER JACKSONVILLE FSU starts season with three straight wins for the first time in school history.

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – The Seminole soccer team got a record-setting win Wednesday night when they defeated the Jacksonville University Dolphins 3-0 in front of 348 fans at the Seminole Soccer Complex. The win marks the first time in the history of the program that the Seminoles have started a season with three straight wins.

"This is a fantastic start to the season," said head coach Patrick Baker. "I am so happy that we are in the position we are in. Beating three very good teams from the state of Florida makes this start even more special."

The Seminoles used three goals from their highly-rated recruiting class to raise their winning streak to three games. Amber Tollefson, a freshman from Boca Raton, Fla., recorded the Seminoles first goal of the evening and her first collegiate goal at the 16:08 mark of the first half.

"I hardly even remember my goal since it happened so fast," said Tollefson. "It's such a great feeling to score my first college goal. When the ball hit the back of the net all I could think was 'wow'. It was such a thrill."

Freshman Emma Breland, from Trelleborg, Sweden, recorded her first and second career goals in the second half. Her first goal came just over seven minutes into the second period and she scored her second goal just over 15 minutes later.

"It felt amazing to finally score," said Breland. "I wanted to just scream when I finally knocked one in. This is so much fun."

The Seminoles out-shot Jacksonville 23-8 and had 12 shots-on-goal to two for the Dolphins. The win marks the first time this season in which FSU hasn't had to come from behind to get a victory. That was a trend FSU worked hard to reverse after going 0-10 when their opponent scored first during the 1999 season.

"When I decided to come here, I knew coach Baker was going to turn this program around and he has," said Tollefson. "It started with Florida and we came off of that high and didn't let down. We won our next two games and I think what we did is amazing. It shows people how we can respond to any situation."

The Seminoles will head to Missouri Thursday to participate in the Missouri Tiger Tournament. FSU will battle Missouri, the 10<sup>th</sup>-ranked team in their region, Friday at 5:00 p.m. and then face Ohio State University, Sunday at 11:00 p.m.
