FLORIDA STATE STOPS NO. 7 TEXAS A&M 4-1 Seminole soccer defeats second top 10 opponent at home.

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. - The Florida State soccer team (4-2) recorded another home win over a top 10 opponent Friday night. The Seminoles used two goals in the first 13 minutes of the game to propel them past the 7th-ranked Texas A&M Aggies (3-2) by a score of 4-1.

Emma Breland led the Seminoles to their fourth consecutive home win with her second multigoal game of the season. The freshman, from Trelleborg, Sweden, recorded her third and fourth career goals and second assist of the season Friday night.

"It has been a little frustrating for me," said Breland. "I haven't been capitalizing on my chances but we practiced a lot of finishing this week and it paid off. I'm starting to settle into the college game and getting a better understanding of where I am supposed to be on the field."

Breland started the scoring just three minutes into the game when she knocked a header past Aggie goalkeeper Angela Baker. Senior Rachael Watkin banged in another header less than 10 minutes later to give the Seminoles a 2-0 lead.

"This was our most complete game of the season," said head coach Patrick Baker. "We were able to solve everything they tried to do in the first 15 minutes. We scored two great goals and it just put the onus on them right off the bat."

The Seminoles went into half-time ahead 2-0 before first-time starter Cindy Schofield extended the Seminoles lead to 3-0 in the 61st minute. Schofield also recorded her second assist of the season on Breland's first goal.

"I have been working hard all summer and I knew it would pay off," said Schofield. "I knew my time would come if I continued to work hard. It is good to get that first goal under your belt and I feel a lot more relaxed now."

The Seminoles 4-0 start at home equals the longest winning streak in team history and is the first time in the history of the program that FSU has started a season with four straight home

wins. It also marks the first time the Seminole soccer team has defeated two nationally ranked opponents in one season.

"Beating two top 10 teams at home is a fantastic start for us," said Baker. "It was an unbelievable win tonight and we did a great job. I am very happy about the way we stepped up and just collectively did everything better than we've done all season."

The Seminoles return to action Sunday, September 10 at 1:00 p.m. at the Seminole Soccer Complex. FSU will host their first ACC opponent of the season when No. 5 Clemson travels to Tallahassee.
