UCLA -- Gutierrez singles to right. Phillips triples scores Gutierrez GAME OVER



HEAD COACHES QUOTES

FLORIDA STATE COACH JOANNE GRAF:

On the winning hit -- "Leslie was playing up a little too far when the ball went over her head. That was a defensive mistake because we didn't realize that she was playing up that far until after the ball was hit. We probably would have noticed after the first pitch, but Phillips hit the very first pitch. It was a coaching mistake on our part."

On Christy Larsen -- "She did a great job of pitching for us. I think she gets stronger as the game goes on and that was evident today. I was proud of the whole team for the way they played, it was just too bad that it had to end like that but we're not done yet. Next time we're going to have to take advantage of our opportunities if we want to win."

UCLA CO-HEAD COACH SUE ENQUIST:

On the lack of hits -- "I don't want to blame anything on the rain delay. We're just disappointed with the offensive production. We're just glad to get the first game under our belts and come out on top."

On the game-winning hit -- "It really suprised me. She (FSU's Leslie Barton) was actually charging when the ball was hit. Our philosophy is that we give our batters the green light. If they're cheating like that, we tell them to go ahead and slap the ball."

On the team -- "We were tight. You have to expect that in the first game. We're a lot more comfortable with each game. We can't overpower the ball. Heather Compton kept us in the game. We're fortunate to have good pitching."

On their next opponent -- "We've faced both ballclubs (UNLV and Arizona). I'm more concerned about our girls coming in and adjusting at the plate."
