FLORIDA STATE CLAIMS CHAMPIONSHIP

TALLAHASSEE, FL-- The Florida State University softball team (33-2) captured the 9th Annual Lady Seminole Invitational downing Kent State 6-0. Leslie Adams led the 'Noles offensively batting 2 for 3 and second baseman Lisa Davidson was 2 for 4. Penny Siqueiros, who was named All-Tournament Shortstop, hit a home run in the third inning driving in three runs.

Florida State defeated Princeton in the semi-finals earlier in the day 2-1. Tournament MVP, Toni Gutierrez hit 2 for 3 along with right fielder Susan Buttery. Kent State reached the championship game by defeating Northern Iowa 7-1 in the other semi-final game.

Gutierrez struck out 27 batters in five games to improve her record to 20-2 from the mound. She also hit 7 for 13 from the plate. Left fielder, Leslie Barton was 6 for 14 including a double home run and four stolen bases.

FSU will host Drexel tomorrow night at 5:30 and 7pm and Kent State will return to Seminole Territory for a double header on Tuesday night at the same time.
