First Inning -- UMASS 1 FSU 0

UMASS -- Aprile singles to right field. Aprile steals second base. Lawson is thrown out on the bunt (2-4) advancing Aprile to third. Marean walks. Kuchinskas is thrown out on the bunt (1-4) scoring Aprile on the squeeze play. Marean advances to second on the play. Bush grounds out (4-3).

For UMASS -- 1 run, 1 hit, 0 errors, 1 LOB

FSU -- Buttery singles up the middle. Mitchem is thrown out on the bunt (1-4) advancing Buttery to second base. Barton singles up the middle advancing Buttery to third base. Barton steals second base. Siqueiros strikes out swinging. Gutierrez grounds out (6-3).

For FSU -- 0 runs, 2 hits, 0 errors, 2 LOB

Second Inning -- UMASS 1 FSU 0

UMASS -- Devlin singles up the middle. Walsh pinch runs for Devlin. Nichols grounds out (4-3) advancing Walsh to second base. Brumm strikes out swinging. Dondarski walks. Aprile grounds out (1-3). Devlin reenters for UMASS.

For UMASS -- 0 runs, 1 hit, 0 errors, 2 LOB

FSU -- Conway grounds out (6-3). Davidson walks. Olow walks advancing Davidson to second base. Gordon grounds to third where Davidson is thrown out on the fielder's choice (5-6). Olow advances to second on the play. Dillmore pinch runs for Gordon. A wild pitch by the pitcher advances Dillmore to second and Olow to third. Buttery strikes out looking. Olow reenters for FSU. (Dillmore pinch ran for Olow and not Gordon).

For FSU -- 0 runs, 0 hits, 0 errors, 2 LOB

Third Inning -- UMASS 2 FSU 0

UMASS -- Lawson reaches first after being hit by a pinch. Lawson advances to second on the wild pitch. Salisbury pinch runs for Lawson. Marean grounds out (3-4) advancing Salisbury to third base. Kuchinskas singles up the middle scoring Salisbury from third base. Bush bunts, Kuchinskas is thrown out at second on the fielder's choice (2-6) as Bush reaches first safely. Devlin pops out to second base. Lawson reenters for UMASS.

For UMASS -- 1 run, 1 hit, 0 errors, 1 LOB

FSU -- Mitchem grounds out (6-3). Barton singles on a dead ball that lands between home plate and third base. Barton steals second base. Barton steals third base. Barton is thrown out at third (5-2-6) on a fielder's choice off of Siqueiros' grounder. She advanced to second on Barton's rundown at third base. Siqueiros advances to third on a wild pitch. Gutierrez grounds out (5-3).

For FSU -- 0 runs, 1 hits, 0 errors, 1 LOB

Fourth Inning -- UMASS 2 FSU 0

UMASS -- Nichols grounds out (5-3). Brumm flies out to center field. Dondarski strikes out looking.

For UMASS -- 0 runs, 0 hits, 0 errors, 0 LOB

FSU -- Conway grounds out (5-3). Davidson singles to right field. Olow grounds out (4-3) advancing Davidson to second base. Gordon lines out to third base.

For FSU -- 0 runs, 1 hit, 0 errors, 1 LOB

Fifth Inning -- UMASS 2 FSU 0

UMASS -- Aprile grounds out (6-3). Lawson singles to left field. Marean pops out to the catcher in foul territory. Kuchinskas grounds out (6-4) on a fielder's choice.

For UMASS -- 0 runs, 1 hit, 0 errors, 1 LOB

FSU -- Buttery singles up the middle. Mitchem grounds up the middle but Buttery is tagged out by the second baseman. Mitchem reaches on the fielder's choice. Barton is hit by a pitch advancing Mitchem to second base. Siqueiros grounds to the shortstop who throw out Mitchem at third (6-5). Siqueiros reaches first on the fielder's choice. Barton advances to second on the play. Gutierrez grounds out (4-3).

For FSU -- 0 runs, 1 hit, 0 errors, 2 LOB

Sixth Inning -- UMASS 2 FSU 2

UMASS -- Bush lines the ball straight to the third baseman for the out. Devlin grounds out (5-3). Nichols grounds out (5-3).

For UMASS -- 0 runs, 0 hits, 0 errors, 0 LOB

FSU -- Conway singles to right field. Conway advances to second on a wild pitch. Davidson singles to right field advancing Conway to third base. Olow singles to right-center field scoring Conway and advancing Davidson to third base. Gordon strikes out swinging. Buttery singles to right field scoring Davidson and advancing Olow to second base. Mitchem pops out to second base. Barton grounds out (5-3).

For FSU -- 2 runs, 4 hits, 0 errors, 2 LOB

Seventh Inning -- UMASS 4 FSU

UMASS -- Brumm grounds to the shortstop but reaches on an error by the first baseman. Dondarski bunts and is thrown out (1-3) advancing Brumm to second. Aprile singles to left field advancing Brumm to third base. Aprile steals second base. Lawson singles to center field scoring Aprile and Brumm. Marean singles to third base advancing Lawson to second base. Kuchinskas grounds to shortstop who turns the double play (6-4-3).

For UMASS -- 2 runs, 3 hits, 1 error, 1 LOB

FSU -- Siqueiros reaches first after being hit by a pitch. Gutierrez grounds to the pitcher who throws out Siqueiros at second (1-4) on the fielder's choice. Conway flies out to right field. Davidson grounds out (6-3).

## POSTGAME COACH'S QUOTES

Game 5 Quotes  
UMass vs. Florida State

Florida State Head Coach Dr. JoAnne Graf:

"I thought UMass took advantage of our mistakes where as we couldn't take advantage of the baserunners we had. We just left too may people on base. I believe we were just sloppy today and we didn't play aggressive or smart. It was little mistakes that killed us today and that was the difference in the ballgame. It's disappointing to lose when you play badly as oppossed to at least playing well."

"We hit Holly (Apirle) well, but she threw a great game in the fact that she kept us at bay and didn't allow us to score once we got on base."

UMass Head Coach Elaine Sortino:

"One thing we hoped is that we would get over the tightness. We came out swinging the bats and we took advantage of our opportunities. Getting out of the gate early helped."

"We got ourselves out of some toughsituations and dodged a lot of bullets today, but we've played that way all year."

"We threw our freshman earlier this year against them (Florida State), but hurt ourselves defensively. This time around we didn't make those mistakes. We knew coming in we could beat Florida State and we proved it."
