**COACHES QUOTES:**

Kansas Head Coach Kalum Haack:

"These were two good ball games. I'm proud of how we played. It says a lot for FSU I thinkd they'll do well in the World Series."

"In the first game our pitcher was fresh- she was a little tired in game two. We were in the position to win both games. In the first game we had runners on second in six of the eight innings. But we didn't get the ball out of the infield. FSU has good pitchers and we struggled some at the plate.."

"FSU put the ball in play today. The two runs that scored (Game 2) were the result of errors. We don't make those errors and we're still playing. But that is part of the game- yesterday the shoe was on the other foot. "

Florida State Head Coach Dr. JoAnne Graf:

"Kansas is an awesome team. All the games could have gone either way. It's a shame that both teams can't go to the College World Series. Had Kansas been in another region they probably would have made it."

"Our experience held us together. When our hitting wasn't there, our pitching was and that kept us in it. It showed character for us to come back after the loss."

"It helped a little bit to see the same pitcher (Stephany Williams) all three times. She's a quality pitcher - she never gave up , we still didn't hit her well in the third game."

"One of the things that we changed in coaching was we told them to put the ball in play- we got some bunts and more runners on board."

"I had my doubts - I never felt sure until the last out."
