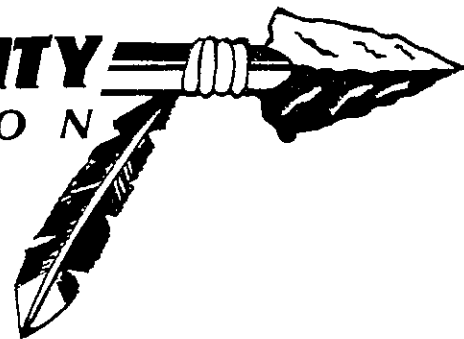

Tallahassee, FL--After falling 11 places in this week's national poll, No. 20 Florida State took out its frustration with a pair of extra inning victories over Hofstra University (9-2), 3-2 and 4-3.

In pushing its current win streak to three, FSU needed some late inning heroics and a little luck. After spotting Hofstra two runs in game one Shamalene Wilson tied the score with a two run homer in the fifth. Heather Feltmann ended the game with one-out in the bottom of the eighth with a triple up the gap in leftcenter scoring Lisa Davidson with the winning run. Wilson, Feltmann and Jen Olow each had two hits apiece for the Seminoles.

Marla Looper scattered four hits, struck out four and walked one to improve her record to 13-5.

Again in the second game Hofstra jumped out to an early 2-0 lead only to see Florida State tie the game with a pair of run scoring sacrifice flies in its half of the second. Leading 3-2 in the bottom of the sixth, Hofstra catcher Tammy Scharf miss-played a two-out pop up in front of the plate. Her error allowed pinch-runner Jennifer Drawdy to score from second base with the tying run.

Leadoff hitter Cindy Lawton started the Seminole eighth with a walk. Picher Amy Phillips then threw wildly to first on Myssi Calkins' bunt single to put runners at second and third with no-outs. The game ended when Phillips served up a wild pitch on her first delivery to Lisa Davidson, plating Lawton with the winning tally.

Kristy Fuentes (9-1) came on in relief of Rebecca Aase to retire the side in order in the eighth and pick up the win. In seven complete innings of work Aase surrendered eight hits, walked one and struck out three. Wilson again provided the FSU spark going 2-for-4 and stealing two bases.

Florida State (33-11) next plays cross-town rival Florida A&M in a single game Monday at 6:00.
