CHAPEL HILL, NC--Florida State began play in the Tar Heel Invitational softball tournament in impressive fashion with a 5-0 blanking of the University of North Carolina-Wilmington and an 8-1 drubbing of the University of North Carolina-Charlotte in the first day of the tournament hosted by the University of North Carolina.

The combination of dominate pitching and good hitting carried FSU to the victories. Florida State hurlers totalled 21 strike outs in the two games, while Seminole bats pounded out 20 hits. In the first game, Marla Looper struck out a season-high 12 Wilmington batters and surrendered a pair of hits to improve her record to 15-5.

The FSU attack was led by Heather Feltmann, Cindy Lawton and Laurie Shepard as the trio each had two hits apiece. A pair of UNC-Wilmington errors put Florida State on the board with two runs in the second. Jen Olow reached first on an error by third baseman Rene Presto to start the inning. Lawton moved her to second with a sacrifice bunt. Olow went to third on Feltmann's single. Windy Weltz grounded sharply to shortstop Lynn Dean who's throw home was too late to nip Olow and got away from catcher Nedea Niedzeicki allowing both runners to move up: Tabatha Doka followed with an RBI single. A fine over-the-shoulder catch of a Shamalene Wilson drive to straight away center field by LeAnn Maultsby ended the inning to prevent further damage.

Florida State added another pair the next inning after Shepard lead off the frame with a double. Weltz tallied her second RBI of the game to drive home Lawton who had earlier plated Shepard.

The Seminoles increased their record to 38-11 with their second victory of the day later in the afternoon against UNC-Charlotte. FSU exploded out of the gates for five first inning runs. FSU batted around as five of the first six batters scored. Myssi Calkins sparked the onslaught with a 3-for-4 performance. Lawton and Shepard continued their hot hitting with two hits each.

Rebecca Aase fanned a season-high nine in picking up her 13th win and second in as many days. Her shutout and no-hit bids were both spoiled in the sixth inning. UNC-Charlotte's Misty Goforth lead off with a single and came into score on Carrie Alcott's two-out single.

Florida State continues pool play with games against Georgia Tech and East Carolina on Saturday.
