FLORIDA STATE SOFTBALL

CHAPEL HILL, NC--Florida State (39-12) split a pair of softball games, losing to East Carolina 1-0 and demolishing Georgia Tech 11-0 on the second day of the Tar Heel Invitational tournament. The Seminoles finish atop their pool concluding the round-robin portion of the tourney with a 3-1 record. They move on to elimination play receiving a first round bye, advancing into Sunday's semifinals.

In the day's first game, FSU came across an East Carolina team playing with the emotion of a squad in the seventh game of the World Series. Florida State had a chance to get on the board in the fourth. With the game scoreless, FSU loaded the bases with one-out. But Pirate pitcher Teryn Ford (10-6) got Wendy Braye to hit into a fielder's choice when third baseman Leann Myers forced pinch-runner Adrienne Pearson at home and closed the door when she got Tabatha Doka to ground to short.

After Myssi Calkins' infield single in the fifth, Ford retired the next seven batters in order to end the game, fanning four of them. Limiting the Seminoles to five hits and striking out five, Ford's breaking ball kept FSU hitters off balance. Everytime an FSU player made solid contact they either hit the ball right at somebody or had the ECU defense rise to the occasion.

Equally impressive was Ford's counterpart Kristy Fuentes (10-2) who takes the loss despite giving up only four hits. ECU threatened in the first when they had runners on the corners with one-out. But Fuentes settled down to get out of the inning and retire 15 of the next 16 batters she faced. Then with one out in the sixth, Lisa Corprew singled up the middle. One out later she scored what proved to be the winning run when Georgeanne Wilke tripled off the left field fence.

Corprew and Wilke combined for all for Pirate hits, each going 2-for-3. Heather Feltmann and Calkins countered with two hits apiece for FSU.

Georgia Tech proved no match for Florida State in the next game as the Seminoles took out their frustration on the Yellow Jackets. Leading 1-0 after four innings FSU exploded for four runs in the fifth and added six more in the sixth. Shamalene Wilson was on fire, belting a pair of triples en route to a 4-for-4 performance. Olow added three hits and three RBI as the Seminoles pounded out a season-high 14 hits.

Lisa Davidson moved atop the FSU chart for doubles when her 38th career two-bagger plated two in the fifth.

Georgia Tech ace Nicki Johnson was roughed up for 10 runs and 11 hits in 5.1 innings of work before giving way to Laura Brown. Five FSU players tallied multiple hits.

Marla Looper scattered five Tech hits and struck out six to improve her record to 16-5.
