#### FLORIDA STATE SOFTBALL

TAMPA, FL--Florida State made a loud statement in its quest for a ninth straight NCAA Regional Tournament appearance with a regular season finale doubleheader sweep of South Florida in Tampa Wednesday.

By taking the first game 4-2 in 10 innings and using a two-run rally in the seventh for a 6-5 triumph in the nightcap, FSU will be hard to overlook with its 50-17 record.

Senior Marla Looper was the pitcher of record in both games and ups her record to 21-7. The Seminoles were cruising along with a 2-0 lead in game one before USF scored in each of the last two frames to force extra innings. Eileen Leary tied the score with a two-out single in the bottom of the seventh to plate Missy Martinez.

Florida State parlayed two South Florida errors into a pair of runs in the 10th. Both teams pounded out 11 hits each, but the Seminoles used six USF errors to score three unearned runs.

Heather Feltmann led the FSU attack with three hits. Myssi Calkins, Cindy Lawton, Laurie Shepard and Wendy Braye added two hits apiece. Rebecca Aase went the first seven innings before giving way to Looper to start the eighth. Kelly Aguilar (12-6) came on in relieve of Kerin Dull for the last two innings.

Florida State appeared headed for an easy time of it in game two when they pushed across four runs in their half of the first. But a feisty South Florida club, bidding farewell to its seniors, answered with two of its own to start the game.

The Bulls then tied it at four when they got to freshman starter Kristy Fuentes in the third for two more runs. Fuentes, making her first start in seven games gave up five hits in three innings of work. South Florida roughed up Looper, who came on to start the fourth, for three hits in the fifth as they took a 5-4 lead.

With the partisan crowd sensing an upset, the Bulls seemed headed for victory until Tina Wood, starting in place of the injured Tabatha Doka in right, led off the seventh with a single to deep short. Shamalene Wilson moved Wood to second with a ground out to first. Calkins collected her second hit of the game with an infield single to put runners on the corners. Lawton tied the game with a sacrifice fly to left and took advantage of left fielder Betsy Holler's miscue, when her attempt to cutdown Calkins at second was wild enabling the speedy freshman to advance to third. Lisa Davidson then delivered the game winning RBI with a single to rightcenter.

South Florida made things interesting in their half of the seventh by putting runners on second and third with one out. But they advanced no further as Looper got Dull to line to first and ended the game when Holler grounded weakly to second.

Both teams combined for 18 hits in the nightcap. Calkins and Wood led the Seminole offense with two hits each. Aguilar went the distance in picking up the loss for USF.

Florida State learns its fate in the NCAA field when the regional pairings are announced Sunday night.
