FLORIDA STATE SOFTBALL

STILLWATER, OK--Strength beat finesse as Oklahoma University (57-13) used a pair of home runs to upend Florida State 3-1 in the first game of the 1994 NCAA Regional Tournament hosted by Oklahoma State University in Stillwater, OK on Friday.

FSU (50-18) opened the contest with a run in its half of the first. Shamalene Wilson led off the game with an opposite field single to left. She came into score when Lisa Davidson delivered a two-out double into the right-centerfield gap. Unfortunately for the Seminoles it would be their last key hit of the game. Florida State could not cash in on its opportunities as it left runners aboard in every inning but one. Every time FSU threatened, OU pitcher Jennifer Sherman closed the door, as the Seminoles stranded nine base runners.

The Sooners captured the lead for good in the bottom of the first. Analisa Jackson opened up with a bad-hop single that went off the head of shortstop Laurie Shepard. She was erased on a Casey Dickson fielder's choice bunt. With two-outs Becky Burroughs deposited a Marla Looper change-up into the left field bleachers for her team-leading, 13th round tripper of the year.

Looper (21-8) limited Oklahoma to four hits. But the Sooners needed no more as two cleared the fence. Christina DeLuca put the final nail in the Seminole coffin by hitting her 10th homer of the year to straight away centerfield to lead off the bottom of the fourth. DeLuca followed with a single before Looper gave way to Rebecca Aase, who retired all nine OU batters she faced.

"The two home runs did us in," commented head coach JoAnne Graf. "Both of them got all ball. There was never a doubt were either one was going to end up."

Lisa Davidson came five feet away from tying the game in the fifth. With Wilson on board thanks to a catcher's interference, Davidson and Sherman engaged in a classic hitter-pitcher duel. Davidson turned on a Sherman rise-ball that brought the 450 fans to their feet as it sailed just wide of the leftfield foul pole for strike two. Davidson fought her way through an 0-2 count for a walk to putting runners on the corners. Sherman then got Jen Olow to hit into a fielder's choice to end the inning.

Davidson, FSU's home run leader, again came up with a chance to tie it in the seventh. Cindy Lawton collected her second hit of the game to keep Florida State's hopes alive and set the stage for Davidson who hit a soft liner to second to end the game.

Florida State, making its ninth consecutive NCAA appearance, must advance through the loser's bracket if it is to make a fifth straight trip to the College World Series. "We have been down this road before," added Graf. "Last year we lost the first game and ended up advancing. We still have a lot of fight left."

FSU will face Big East champion Providence in an elimination game. The Friars lost to 4th ranked Oklahoma State 1-0 on Friday. OSU and Oklahoma square off Saturday with the loser playing the FSU-Providence winner later in the day, while the victor moves into Sunday's championship game.
