Game #3 • Arizona vs. Florida State Wildcats Come Back to Win Hard-Hitting Battle

Tallahassee, Fla.--In Saturday's first game of the NCAA Regional at Lady Seminole Field, #1 seed Arizona defeated #3 seed Florida State 9-6. FSU saw a 5-0 lead in the third inning vanish as Arizona took advantage of Seminole errors to score four runs in the fourth and two more in the fifth. Arizona, ranked #2 in the nation, improves its record to 53-9, while #16-ranked Florida State drops to 50-20.

Wildcat second baseman Jenny Dalton again came through in the clutch, hitting a 3-run homer in the bottom of the sixth to put Arizona ahead for good. Dalton broke the NCAA all-time RBI record in last night's game with a grand slam. Wildcat pitcher Lisa Pitt went the distance, allowing nine hits and striking out one, improving her record to 17-3.

Seminole pitcher Renee Espinoza pitched her second complete game in as many days, allowing nine hits while striking out four. Her record falls to 29-7. Catcher Kristy Hull went 3-4 from the plate, scoring two runs, and Seminole shortstop Jesse McGregor had two hits and three RBI's.

Arizona advances to Sunday's championship game at 1:00. Florida State will take the field again today at 5:00, meeting the winner of the Troy State-South Florida game this afternoon.
