FSU TOPS JACKETS IN TECH'S FIRST-EVER TELEVISED SOFTBALL DOUBLEHEADER\

ATLANTA -- The Georgia Tech softball team (13-13 overall, 2-2 ACC) lost 5-1 and 8-5 to 21st-ranked Florida State (25-12) in a doubleheader at Glenn Field on Sunday. Both games were taped by FOX SportSouth and will be aired on March 31 from 6:30-9 p.m., marking the first time that Tech has had entire softball games televised.\

Tech tied the first game at 1-1 on a second inning home run to left field by senior first baseman Lori Steiner. However, Florida State regained the lead behind the bat of second baseman Windy Weltz, who was 4-for-4 with three runs scored and one RBI in the game.\

FSU's Kristy Fuentes tossed a complete game, improving to 16-5 after allowing only three hits and tossing four strikeouts. Tech's Carey Schiller gave up only one hit in three innings of relief, but the Jackets were hampered by four errors, tying their season high.\

The Lady Seminoles seized control of game two in the first inning when first baseman Misty Molin tripled to score left fielder Myssi Calkins. Molin and shortstop Jesse McGregor then scored on a two-out single by centerfielder Dana Bailey.\

FSU's lead would swell to 5-0 before Tech rallied in the bottom of the fifth for three runs, the last of which was scored by right fielder Heather Sumrow, who was 2-for-3 with two runs and one RBI in the game. However, Calkins hit a single up the middle that scored two runs for the Seminoles in the seventh, sealing the win.\
