BROOKS EARNS ALL-AMERICAN

Serita Brooks was named to the 2000 Louisville Slugger All-America second team. Brooks, who started all 78 games at center field for Florida State, led the Lady Seminoles and the Atlantic Coast Conference with a .401 batting average. A first team all-Southeast Region selection, Brooks also earned all-tournament team honors at the Los Angeles regional after batting .317 with three RBI. She was the team leader in hits with 99, runs scored with 54, triples with eight, stolen bases with 42 and at bats with 247. An All-ACC selection, Brooks, whose 99 hits tied the FSU single-season record, had 30 multi-hit games on the year and hit safely in 23 of the last 25 games of the season.

With the distinction, Brooks become the 18th Lady Seminole softball player to earn All-America honors.

COACH'S CORNER

Completing her 22nd season at the helm of the Lady Seminole program, Dr. JoAnne Graf's record stands at 1055-312-6. In 1999, Graf became the first coach in NCAA Division I history to amass 1,000 Division I victories and the first to reach that plateau at one university. She has guided FSU to five College World Series, 13 NCAA Regional appearances, two slowpitch National Championships and eight ACC Championships. Her coaching has produced 18 All-Americans and numerous all-region and all-conference selections.

WHAT SHE DID

With practically an entire new team and coaching staff, Coach Graf had quite a year! Just three starters and 11 letterwinners returned from last year's squad. With the exception of the catcher, FSU replaced the entire infield and also had newcomers in both left and center fields. This year's pitching ace Leslie Malerich started just 19 games last year and had just 12 complete games. Coach Graf also welcomed a new staff in assistants Louie Berndt and Heather Compton. The Lady Seminoles met nearly all their goals this season ... achieving a team GPA of over 3.0 (3.07), winning the ACC and getting to regionals.

FSU IN NCAA REGIONAL PLAY

Florida State made its 13th NCAA Regionals appearance when the Lady Seminoles headed to Los Angeles, California. FSU's first regional appearance was in 1986. FSU's all-time record in NCAA regional play is 21-17.

HEADING HOME!

California natives Assistant Coach Heather Compton and Brandi Stuart are excited that the Lady Seminoles are headed west. Stuart is from Cerritos, Calif., while Compton's ties are even stronger. Compton is a 1994 graduate of UCLA where she earned a degree in political science while lettering for the Bruins for four seasons. An All-American, Compton led UCLA to the College World Series in each of her four years and was a member of the Bruins' 1990 and 1992 national championship teams. Kelly Miller, who has been unable to play since April 15th with a thumb fracture and will not travel, is from Vallejo, Calif.

FSU AND THE COLLEGE WORLD SERIES

The Lady Seminoles have advanced to the College World Series five times. FSU's first appearance at the CWS was in 1987. After a two-year absence, the Tribe returned to the event in 1990 and went again in 1991, 1992 and made its last appearance in 1993. FSU's all-time CWS record is 3-10 and its best finish was 3rd in 1990.

THE TRIBE VS. THE REGIONAL FIELD

Florida State had already faced two of the six teams in the regional field this season. The Tribe swept Bethune-Cookman, 9-0 and 1-0, in Daytona back on Feb. 19th and fell to UCLA, 3-0, on March 10th in Fresno, Calif.

FSU VS. THE 48-TEAM FIELD

Florida State played 14 of the other 47 teams participating in NCAA regionals. Of those 14 opponents, two are No. 1 seeds and three are hosting. FSU was 9-15 against those opponents this season.

WHY IMPORTANT?

FSU's last road swing to Virginia and Maryland may have been the most important series of the season. With the sweep of both Virginia and Maryland, the Lady Seminoles earned the SASA automatic bid to regionals. The five ACC schools and East Carolina make up the Southern Atlantic Softball Alliance. All six teams play a doubleheader throughout the season and the team with

WINNING STREAK

MISS CLUTCH

Teresa Edenfield made just about every hit count. The senior has 50 hits on the year and a team-leading 46 RBI off those hits. Edenfield had the best season of her FSU career. Coming into the season, she had just 34 career RBI. With her 46 this year, she more than doubled that mark. She had 12 career doubles through the first three years and had 11 in 2000 alone. She also set marks in hits with 50 (previous high was 31 in 1998), and home runs with four (had just one previously).

ALL-ACC HONORS

Four Florida State softball players garnered All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors for the 2000 season. Staci Brandon, Serita Brooks, Leslie Malerich and Brandi Stuart were all selected to the squad after leading the team to FSU's 8th ACC Tournament crown.

MALERICH AMONG ELITE GROUP

Leslie Malerich led the Seminole pitching staff with 35 wins. She picked up three wins alone in the final day of the ACC Tournament with the last win giving her her 30th win of the season. Only four other FSU pitchers have reached the 30-win mark since the Tribe went to fastpitch in 1984. They are Christy Larsen, 33 (1991); Toni Gutierrez, 35 (1992); Renee Espinoza, 30 (1996) and Kristy Fuentes, 32 (1997).

EDENFIELD WAS ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Teresa Edenfield was named the ACC Player of the Week for May 8th, after leading the Lady Seminoles to a sweep of Virginia and Maryland. A native of Marianna, Fla., Edenfield was the Lady Seminoles' offensive leader as she went 5-12 and provided key hits in two of Florida State's wins. In the first game at Virginia, the senior left fielder and catcher had a two-run double that plated the winning run in FSU's 3-2 come-from-behind victory over the Cavaliers. In game one of FSU's doubleheader with Maryland, her two-run homer gave FSU a 5-3 advantage and the Lady Seminoles went on to earn a 10-3 win. On the week, Edenfield recorded five RBI's, a double and home run to go along with her .417 batting average.

RECORDS AND NEARING RECORDS

With 58 appearances this season, Leslie Malerich has surpassed the previous record of 48 appearances held by Kristy Fuentes in 1997. Serita Brooks set a new record for single season with 99, passing Danielle Cox's record of 98 hits set in 1999. She also set the at bats record with 247, passing Susan Buttery who had 240 in 1992. Teresa Edenfield's 46 RBIs was just three away from the single season mark of 49 set by Penny Siqueiros in 1992. With 49 strikeouts, Edenfield also set a new single-season mark, surpassing Leslie Barton's 42 in the 1991 season. Natalie Bennett's 22 sacrifices was just three away from Shannon Mitchem's 25 in 1992.

GO-TO GIRL

FSU won 17 of its last 19 regular-season games and Leslie Malerich was probably the main reason. Malerich earned 13 of those victories and was the pitcher of record, going 8-2, in 10 straight games from April 8th to April 21st.

ON A ROLL

Heading into the ACC Tournament, Brandi Stuart was on a 10-game hitting streak and had hit safely in 17 of the last 20 games. In the tourney, however, Stuart went hitless until the final game, in which she had a single.

GET THE BROOM OUT

The Tribe recorded 12 sweeps this season, including the last five series of the year.

PUTTING A STOP TO 'EM

ACC Tourney MVP Leslie Malerich pitched 17 and two-thirds innings of shutout ball in the final day of the ACC Tournament. Prior to Auburn's run in the 13th inning in the second game of the doubleheader on April 15th, Malerich had pitched 25.1 consecutive innings without giving up a run. She pitched 16 innings that Saturday alone. Early in the season, Malerich had a stretch

in which she didn't give up an earned run in 46 consecutive innings.

SHUTTING 'EM OUT!

Florida State pitching produced 23 shutouts this season, including a no-hitter against Florida A&M and a perfect game against Princeton. Leslie Malerich led the unit with 16 solo and two combined shutouts. The Lady Seminoles have been shut out seven times this year.

HOME RUN CLUB

The Lady Seminoles had 17 home runs this season while FSU pitching has allowed 13. The Tribe had a total of seven last season. Teresa Edenfield led the team with four, Kelly Miller had three while Kimmy Carter, Brandi Stuart, Natalie Bennett and Serita Brooks each had two and Jenn White-Stokes and Andi Lyons each had one.

ON THE BASEPATHS

The Lady Seminoles definitely have speed in the line up. Serita Brooks and Brandi Stuart led the team with 42 apiece. As a team, FSU recorded 117 stolen bases to its opponents' 38.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

The Lady Seminoles were 48-25 heading into regionals. Eleven of the Tribe's 25 losses in the regular season were by just one run and five of those games went extra innings before being decided.

FSU IN THE ACC TOURNAMENT

- FSU's overall ACC Tournament record is 28-6.
- FSU has won eight of nine ACC Tournament titles.
