FLORIDA STATE OPENS NCAA REGIONAL PLAY WITH 6-2 WIN OVER BETUNE-COOKMAN

COLLEGE

Brooks sparks the Seminoles with a 3-for-3 day at the plate, an RBI, two runs scored and five steals.

Tallahassee, FL — The 16th-ranked Seminole softball team got off to a good start at the 2001 NCAA Tallahassee Regional Thursday afternoon by downing Bethune-Cookman 6-2 and advancing in the winner's bracket on the opening day of postseason play. Florida State (55-10) was led by senior All-American Serita Brooks who almost single-handedly brought FSU back from an early 2-0 deficit to help the Seminoles get past a strong Bethune-Cookman (45-22) team. Florida State will next face Bethune-Cookman, Florida or Connecticut in a second-round game tomorrow at 8:00 p.m.

"You have got to give Serita and Leslie a lot of credit today," said head coach JoAnne Graf. "Serita jump started our team today and put her game in high gear. She got us going and brought us back from a 2-0 hole by playing a major role in our first three runs. She did an exceptional job today."

The Wildcats jumped on top of FSU in the first inning when Lamia Scott led off with a single to left field. After Ange Williams reached safely on a bunt, LaTash Robertson sacrificed the runners over to second and third. BCC got its first run after FSU catcher Kimmy Carter attempted to pickoff Scott at third and the ball ended up in left field allowing Scott to score and moving Williams to third. Jessica Cabato then singled to center field scoring Williams and staking Bethune-Cookman to a 2-0 lead.

The Seminoles cut into the BCC lead in the bottom of the first when Brooks led off with a single to center field. After she stole second and third, her 49th and 50th consecutive steals of the year, Jessica van der Linden singled to center scoring Brooks with van der Linden's 34th RBI of the season. Florida State evened the game at 2-2 in the second when left fielder Monique Marier doubled down the left field line to open the bottom of the inning. Pinch runner Skyla Cox came around to score two batters later when Brooks recorded her second single and first RBI of the game.

The game remained tied into the bottom of the fifth when Brooks once again made things happen for Florida State and gave the Seminoles a 3-2 lead. The senior led off the bottom half of the inning with her third hit of the game and stole her fourth and fifth bases of the day. She came around to score when BCC catcher Anna Cindric attempted to throw her out at third and the ball ended up in left field. Brooks was 3-for-3 on the day with two runs scored, an RBI, a walk and five stolen bases.

"I had an opportunity to do some good things to help our team win today," said Brooks. "I was fortunate today but our team came out ready to hit the ball. Even though we struggled last weekend at ACC's, we were ready today and that was the most important thing for us."

Florida State added three insurance runs in the bottom of the sixth when sophomore Brandi Stuart drew a lead off walk and then stole her 29th base of the season. All-Southeast Region first-teamer Jen White-Stokes then reached on an error by the BCC catcher advancing Stuart to third. Stuart came around to score on Marier's team-leading 39th RBI of the season. FSU moved out in front 5-2 when pinch runner Leah Armstrong scored on a wild pitch by relief pitcher Miranda Mayse (27-10) and Staci Brandon finished the inning off by singling to right field scoring Marier to give Florida State the 6-2 lead.

"We just gave it away today," said Bethune-Cookman head coach Laura Watten. "We had too many mental mistakes. We knew we could hang in there with them but we just didn't fight hard enough. We hit the ball well but we just didn't execute on defense."

After allowing two runs in the top of the first, ACC Player of the Year Malerich (23-3) settled down and retired the Wildcats in order in four of the next six innings while allowing just four hits, striking out five batters and issuing no walks. Her ERA now stands at 0.72 for the season and she recorded her 23rd complete game win of the year.

Florida State will have to wait to find out who they will face in the second round of the 2001 NCAA Tournament. Connecticut and Bethune-Cookman will meet in the 8:00 p.m. elimination game Thursday night with the winner advancing to take on Florida at 3:00 p.m. Friday in another elimination match. The Seminoles will face the winner of Friday's game.
