ACC RIVAL GEORGIA TECH DOWNS FSU SOFTBALL AT NCAA TOURNAMENT Seminoles must fight their way through the loser bracket to get back to WCWS.

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. — In 15 trips to the NCAA Softball Tournament, the 21st-ranked Seminole softball team had never faced an ACC school and after Friday's 7-0 loss to Georgia Tech they hope they won't ever have to again. The Yellow Jackets (51-16) capitalized on three FSU errors in handing the Tribe (50-18) their worst loss since an 8-1 defeat at the hands of Cal State Fullerton March 15. It has been 97 games since the Garnet and Gold have lost by more than seven runs dating back to April 9, 2000 when Florida State lost 9-0 to Southern Mississippi in Tallahassee, FL.

This is just the sixth time FSU has been held scoreless in 2002 and two of the six have come against the Yellow Jackets. The Seminoles have now lost three of their last four games and four of their last six since facing Florida Atlantic in the last series of the regular season.

After Jessica Sallinger (27-7) retired the Seminoles in order in the first, Tech got to work in the bottom of the frame loading the bases off Jessica van der Linden (16-6) with no outs on two walks and a double. Catcher Lindsay Wood then singled to shallow left field to score the game's first run as the bases remained full with no one out. The Jackets added to the lead on two infield errors as they moved out to a 3-0 lead and still no outs in the inning. After Leslie Malerich came in to relieve van der Linden, the Seminoles got a force out at home, a pop out to the pitcher before another run scored on a shallow hit to left field. With Georgia Tech now up 4-0, Malerich got the last out of the inning on a pop to second.

The Yellow Jackets added to their 4-0 lead in the fourth as they utilized another FSU error and a walk to put two runners on with one away. Malerich got the next batter on a deep fly to left before Tara Knudsen lined a shot into left field scoring Georgia Tech's fifth run of the afternoon. She was followed by Lindsay Wood who sent Tech's fourth double of the game into the gap in right center clearing the bases to put the Yellow Jackets in front 7-0.

Florida State could muster just three hits on the day with two coming off ACC Rookie of the Year Sallinger. Shundra Colzie, Jessica van der Linden and Brandi Stuart were they only Seminoles to have any success at the plate as the team's overall batting average fell to .171 in two games at the 2002 NCAA Tallahassee Regional and the Tribe is hitting just .193 in the ACC and NCAA Tournaments. Freshman hurler Casey Hunter closed the game out with two innings of shutout ball.

The Seminoles will have to wait to find out who and when they will play next in an elimination game. If Florida Atlantic defeats UTC at 8:00 p.m., the Seminoles will play the Mocs at 1:00 p.m. Saturday. If UTC ousts the Owls, FSU will play the UTC/GT loser at 6:00 p.m. Saturday. Georgia Tech Advances In Winner's Bracket With 7-0 Win Over Florida State

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – The Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets belted eight hits on their way to a 7-0 win over Florida State Friday afternoon in Game 6 of the Tallahassee Regional. With the win, Georgia Tech advanced in the winner's bracket to Game 9 to be played on Saturday at 3:30 p.m. vs. the winner of tonight's Chattanooga/Florida Atlantic game.

"Everything is coming together, everybody is playing together," Georgia Tech Kate Madden said. "It's not only Jess (Sallinger), who is pitching out of her mind, but the defense is still playing awesome and everybody is stepping up at the plate. We had two pinch-hits where our girls are coming in ripping the ball. It is so obvious to me that they want to win."

The Yellow Jackets, who improved to 51-16, wasted no time getting things going offensively. With the bases loaded and no outs in the bottom of the first inning, Lindsay Wood drove in the first run with a single to left field. What followed were two straight Florida State errors, which resulted in two more Tech runs. Tara Neff's two-out single scored Georgia Tech's fourth run of the inning.

Florida State could not get anything going offensively and managed just three hits for the afternoon as Georgia Tech freshman pitcher Jessica Sallinger (27-7) struck out six batters and walked none in five innings of work. FSU's Jessica van der Linden started the game on the mound, but was replaced in the first inning by senior Leslie Malerich, after facing six batters. The four runs in the first inning were charged to van der Linden, who went to 16-6 on the year with the loss, but just one run was earned due to the two Seminole errors.

"Basically, I think we got shellacked," FSU Head Coach Dr. JoAnne Graf said. "We didn't come out strong and they got started and got the momentum going immediately and took us out of the game right away.

"We didn't do anything offensively to help our cause, but it's hard when a team gets up on you four runs in the first inning with the caliber pitcher they have. It makes it awful tough."

Georgia Tech picked up three more runs in the fourth inning. With one out, Neff reached on an error and later scored on a double by Tara Knudsen. A double to center by Wood scored two more Yellow Jacket runs. For the day, Wood went 2-for-3 with three RBIs.

FSU's next game will be Saturday at either 1 p.m. or 6 p.m., depending on the outcome of tonight's Chattanooga/Florida Atlantic game.
