## Lady Seminoles cop second in swim meet

GAINESVILLE, Ga.— Mary Montgomery set an NCAA record and Susan Clark won her third event in the three-day meet, as Florida State managed second place in the National Collegiate Invitational Swim Meet for Women Saturday here.

FSU finished with 501 points, while Indian River Community College claimed first with 613. Brenau of Gainesville and the University of Georgia tied for third with 184.

Montgomery set her record in the 800-yard freestyle, as she clocked in at 8:16.4. Susan Clark won the 100 butterfly in 59.0, following earlier victories in the 50 butterfly and 100 individual medley.

Pennie Knutsen finished second in the 100 breaststroke in an FSU record time of 1:10.8.

## Women 2nd

Florida State's Lady Seminole swimming team splashed to a second place finish in the National Collegiate Invitational Swim Meet for Women Saturday, finishing with 501 points to Indian River Community College's 613.

The University of Georgia finished third with 184 points.

The Lady Seminoles opened the competition Thursday by placing six swimmers in the 400-yard freestyle, three who finished with national qualifying times.

Mary Montgomery treaded the fastest time in the 400 with a time of 4:01.1, the best time in this event.

Susie Clark set a new national record this year with a 1:01 time in the 100-yard individual medley. Katie Jones came in second while Penny Knutsen was fifth.

In the 400-yard medley relay, FSU's strongest event all season, the Seminoles finished second behind Indian River with a time of 4:08.4.

On Saturday Mary Montgomery set another record in the 800-yard freestyle with a time of 8:16.4. Susie Clark won the 100-yard butterfly in 59.0, adding to her earlier victories in the 50-yard butterfly and the 100-yard individual medley.
