

## Coaching Staff

In three seasons as head coach of the Lady Seminole tennis program, Anne Davis' teams have attained almost every goal she has set for them.

In 1981, Florida State won its first Metro Conference women's tennis championship which earned Davis Metro Coach of the Year honors. Last year her goals became a reality with a pre-season Top 20 ranking, a 23-18 dual match record and finally a sixth place finish at the AIAW National Championships.

Davis' success is not surprising; she has a history of accomplishing what she sets out to do. As a former varsity tennis player for the University of South Florida, she played in the top four slots all four years and teamed up to form USF's no. 1 doubles unit. In her junior year, the Brahmanas finished 11th in the nation and 13th in her senior season. After earning a bachelor's degree in marketing, Davis remained on campus and became assistant coach at USF. She helped guide the team to an 11th place showing nationally.

Davis has also served as AIAW Region III tennis chairperson and was responsible for organizing region III's tennis activities. Breaking away from her busy schedule, she also managed time to complete her master's degree in guidance and counseling from South Florida.

"I believe that we have definitely made progress towards our goal of re-establishing FSU as a national tennis power," said Davis. "In the past our goals were to make the Top 20 rankings; but now that's not sufficient. We want to continue on until we reach the top."

Assisting Davis this year is Cathy Strange who played her collegiate tennis at the University of North Carolina-Greensboro. Strange was also a member of the

varsity basketball and volleyball squads while at UNC-Greensboro. After completing her collegiate career, Strange played professional basketball in the Women's Basketball League. She obtained her bachelor's and master's degrees in physical education from UNC-Greensboro. Her primary functions with the Seminoles will be to assist Davis with the physical conditioning and academic counseling of the team.

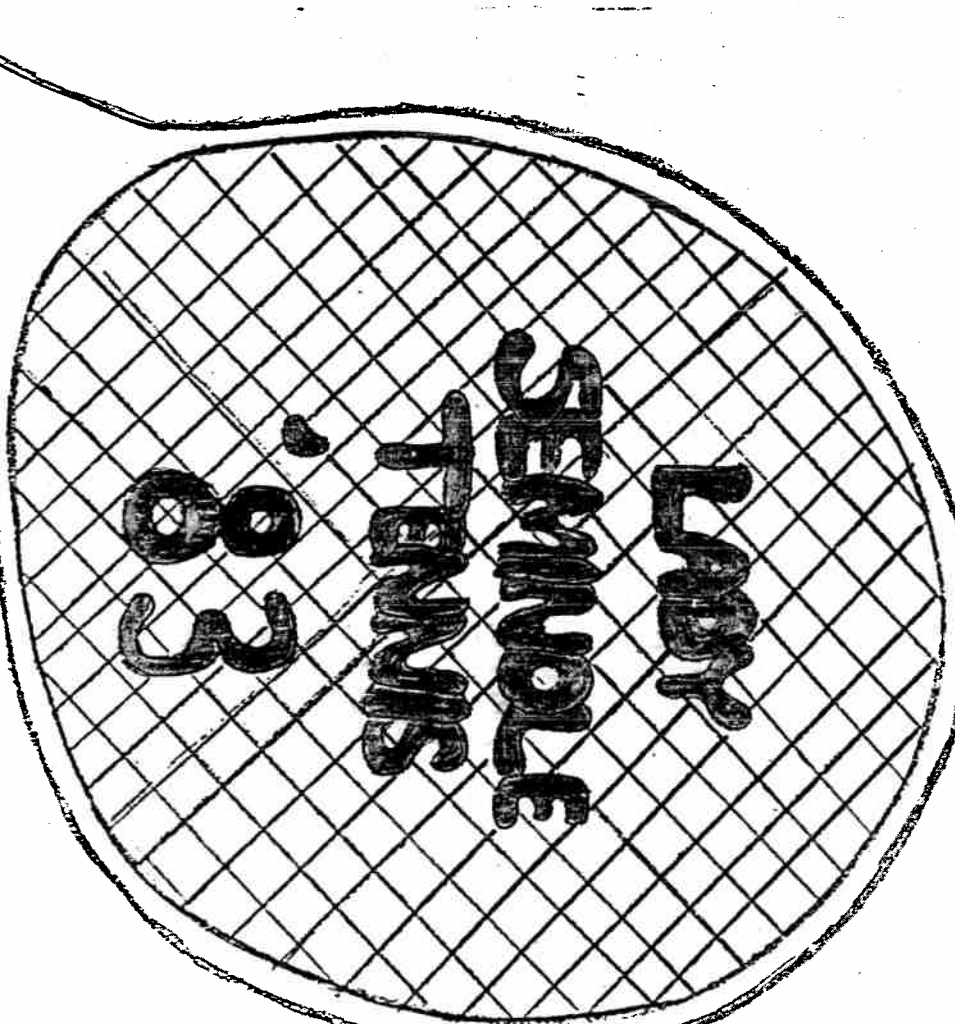

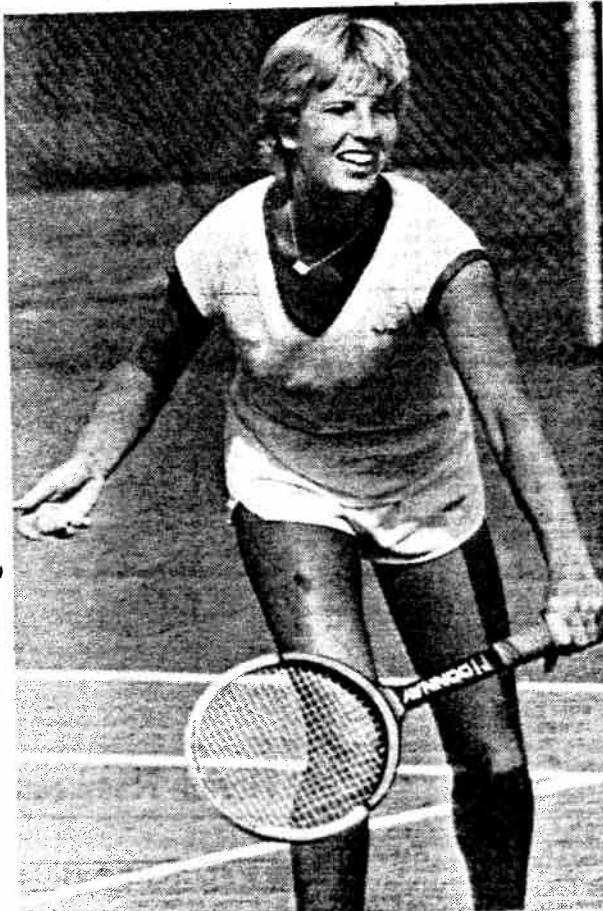

Though several members of the Florida State women's tennis team have seen tournament action, the test of team ability comes this weekend when the women travel to Columbia, South Carolina to participate in the Carolina Fall Classic.

Clemson, Indiana, Duke, Georgia, South Florida, North and South Carolina round out the eight-team field. First round action begins on Saturday as FSU faces North Carolina.

"This should be our toughest tournament all year. I think we'll do very well. Everyone is eager to get this season started. We have a good combination of new people and experienced players, and we expect to be strong throughout the line-up," head coach Anne Davis said.

The top eight players traveling to South Carolina are Lee McGuire, winner this past weekend of the Jerry Lewis Muscular Dystrophy Tournament, Suzanne Doumar, third place finisher in the Sun Life Tennis Classic in Syracuse, N.Y. and Florida Federal Open winner Jaime Kaplan, as well as Lisa Ehrgot, Debbie Pollack and Patty Henderson. Henderson, sporting a number six ranking for 18-year-olds in Canada, is the only freshman traveling with the team.

The men's team will be on the road to Athens, Ga. this weekend to try for top honors in the Southern Intercollegiate Invitational Tennis Championship. The University of Georgia hosts this individual single elimination tournament. Team points are compiled for each players' win and the team with the highest point total wins. A draw of 128 players is expected.

Head coach Randy Jobson lists the top five players for this tournament as Jon McLean, Hernan Luque, Joey Rive, Scott Blessing and Jeff Horine. Conspicuously missing from that list is Marco Abilhoa who will remain at home nursing a sore arm.

"We have an excellent chance of our players advancing far in this tournament. Two seniors, John and Hernan, have three years playing experience in this tournament," said Jobson.

The Southern Intercollegiate is one of the seven fall events the team uses to prepare for the spring schedule.
