

FSU's Henderson reaches quarterfinals

BATON ROUGE, La. — Florida State's women's tennis players are competing in the Lady Tiger Fall Invitational this weekend in Baton Rouge. Louisiana State University hosts the event for individual college players throughout the country.

Patti Henderson is the only FSU player left in singles competition as she competes in the quarterfinals today. She has defeated Cynthia Vanderslice of Centenary College 6-1, 6-4 and Eileen Curreri of Rice University 6-2, 6-7, 6-1.

In doubles, Kim Temples and Darlene Finegan of FSU have defeated Lovette and Windsor of South Carolina 6-2, 7-6 to reach today's second round. Henderson and Sue Hatch, the No. 2 seed, received a first round bye and will also compete in today's second round.
