TALLAHASSEE, FL-- The Florida State Women's Tennis Team fell to 23rd ranked Clemson 5-4 at Tom Brown Park.

Clemson built a 4-2 lead following singles and held off a comeback attempt by Florida State in doubles.

Florida State earned their two singles points at the number one and two positions. Audra Brannon rolled past Boba Tzvetkova at number one, 6-4, 6-2. At two, Laura Randmaa ousted Janice Durden, 6-3, 6-2.

All three of the doubles matches went to three matches. Clemson secured the win as Durden and King rallied back to defeat Brannon and Randmaa, 6-2, 2-6, 7-5.
