Tallahassee, FL--The Florida State Women's Tennis Team responded to a narrow loss the previous day to Clemson with a resounding 7-2 win over 24th ranked Glemson. North Corolland

The highlight of the match was a straight set victory by Audra Brannon and Laura Randmaa over the nation's number one doubles team, Cinda Gurney and Alisha Portnoy in the #1 doubles match.

Jenny Graf had given the Lady Seminoles a 4-2 lead going into doubles play. The junior from Clearwater, FL, broke back to beat Alisha Portnoy, 0-6, 6-2, 7-6 at the number four position.

Laura Randmaa, Elke Juul and Jen Hyde also notched singles points for Florida State.

Florida State increases to 6-5 overall and 2-1 in the ACC while North Carolina drops to 3-4 and 0-1 in the conference.
