Charlottesville, VA--The Florida State Women's Tennis Team upset 17th ranked Virginia 5-4 in Charlottesville on Wednesday.

Doubles play proved to be the decisive factor for Florida State as the match was knotted up 3-3 following singles action. Florida State's number three doubles team of Elke Juul and Sandi Ecclestone gave the Lady Seminoles the lead in the match by defeating Leigh Buchart and Whitney Sharp 6-4, 6-4. Audra Brannon and Laura Randmaa, ranked 24th in the nation, clinched the victory for FSU with a 7-6, 6-4 victory over Jen Callen and Karen Kerr at number one.

Florida State earned their three singles points at the number two, three and four positions. Laura Randmaa, ranked 83rd in the latest poll, ousted Chrissy D'Angio 6-1, 6-0. Elke Juul, a freshman from Colloroy Beach, Austrailia, brought her record to an impressive 13-3 mark with a win over Ly-Lan Schofield, 6-1, 6-2. Jenny Graf tallied FSU's last singles point by cruising past Karen Kerr, 6-3, 6-2.

Florida State improved to 10-7 overall and 5-2 in the Atlantic Coast Conference.
