TALLAHASSEE, FL-- The Florida State women's tennis team defeated N.C. State 7-2, at the Scott Speicher Tennis Center on Sunday.

The Seminoles swept the Wolfpack in all matches, but lost two points to injuries on the team.

Florida State's Audra Brannon lost the first set 6-1, but came back with two decisive wins, 6-0, 6-1 over N.C. State's Kylie Hunt for the number 1 position. The most exciting match of the day was another come from behind victory for the Seminoles. After falling 4-6 in the first set, Elke Juul of Florida State followed up that loss with two strait 6-1 wins over Margie Zimmer.

In doubles, Brannon and Juul earned a point for the Seminoles as they defeated Kylie Hunt and Beth Shaefer, 7-5, 6-3.

The Seminoles improved to a 5-5 record overall, and 4-1 in the Atlantic Coast Conference. The next match for the 'Noles is the University of Virginia on Tuesday, March 15
