Match Comments: Duke advances to the semifinals of the tournament to face the winner of the Virginia-Maryland match on Saturday at 2:00 PM...with the win over Florida State, the Blue Devils claimed their 100th consecutive victory over conference opponents, which is believed to be the longest streak for any sport in ACC history with Maryland wrestling coming in a distant second at 70-straight wins...in ACC Tournament play, Duke owns a 35-2 record with its only losses coming against Clemson...the Blue Devils are currently on a 10-match win streak...Laura Zifer, 1998 ACC flight champion No. 6 singles, posted the match-clinching victory with a two-set win to improve her career record to 85-24, including a 21-5 mark this season...No. 3 ranked Vanessa Webb, the flight champion at No. 1, won her 10th straight match and her 17 in the last 18 matches, improving her career record to 108-20 with a 34-7 mark in 1998.
