### FSU Women's Tennis Wraps Up Play at Southern Regional Championships

*Dumitrescu posts tough loss to eventual singles bracket winner Florida's Jennifer Magley; Clarke wins consolation singles bracket.*

**Tallahassee** - The Florida State women's tennis team completed the first day of the ITA Southern Regional Championships on Friday in Athens, GA. The three-day event, hosted by the University of Georgia Bulldogs, is taking place at Dan Magill Tennis Complex.

In doubles A bracket action, junior Mihaela Moldovan and senior Christina Denny made it to the third round before being losing the tiebreaker 9-8(1) to Minor/Koppelle from Alabama. Senior Anca Dumitrescu and newcomer Roxanne Clarke also paired up but lost in the second round to Stephenson/Bentley from Alabama, 9-7.

In the singles A bracket, Dumitrescu won the fourth round to setup a match between Florida's Jennifer Magley. Dumitrescu lost the first set (6-1) and battled back to 5-5 serve before dropping the match 7-5. Magley went on to win one of two singles championship brackets, earning a spot at the NCAA National Indoor Championships

In the upper bracket of singles A, Mihaela Moldovan made it to the fourth round on Sunday before losing to Katarina Palenikova, 6-4, 1-6, 6-3. Daniela Gheorghe lost in the first round to Miami's Staci Stevens, 6-0, 6-4 as did senior Christina Denny, who dropping the match to South Florida's Gabriela Duch 6-4, 6-1 in the first round.

After losing in the first round to Karem Harboe from Ole Miss, 6-1, 6-1, newcomer Roxanne Clarke went on to win four straight consolation rounds winning the last round from Lord Andrade from South Florida by default.

In the first two rounds of B singles, Alina Mihailescu and Natalie Tirapelli breezed through competition, with both receiving first round byes. Mihailescu defeated Courtney Jonson from Florida International 6-1, 6-4 and then went on to beat Sonja Nikolic from Alabama 6-3, 6-2. After meeting Yumi Ueda from Mississippi State in the third round on Sunday morning and winning 1-6, 6-3, 6-2, the Constanta, Romania native

met fellow Nole Natalie Tirapelli whom she bested 6-3, 6-1. In all, Mihailescu lost 2 sets, playing seven total.

En route to meeting Mihailescu, Tirapelli played Marritt Jansma from Alabama Birmingham defeating her in straight sets 6-3, 6-3, advancing to the third round to face Mississippi State's Hayley Rudman. She lost the first set 1-6 but came back to win 6-3, 6-2 to stay alive for one more round. On Sunday morning, the St. Petersburg, Fla. native met Nikhila Narra from Southern Mississippi besting her 6-2, 6-3 to but eventually lost to Mihailescu in her final round. She dropped two sets 6-3, 6-1.

In the singles A upper bracket, senior Nicole Cercone received a first round bye, going on to face Beth Hayden from Stetson in the second round on Friday. Hayden won 1-6, 6-4, 6-1.

In doubles B action, the team of Mihailescu and Tirapelli, won the first three rounds before defaulting in the fourth round. FSU beat Epps/Gray from Auburn (8-6), Bohannon/Levin from Stetson (8-1) and Guerrero/Johnson from Florida International (8-1) before bowing out the fourth round.

In the same bracket, Cercone teamed with Stauss from Georgia Tech to defeat Alarcon/Jones from Troy State 8-6. The pair lost the second round to Serret/Rudman from Mississippi State 8-3.

The 2003 ITA National Intercollegiate Indoor Championships the national's premier collegiate indoor tennis tournament is the second of three national championship events held during the 2003-04. This first two, ITA Women's All-American Championships, took place in Los Angeles while the third event is a season ending NCAA Championships held in May.

The Noles next tournament is the USF Invitational taking place October 24-26 in Tampa, Fla.

**FSU Women's Tennis Wraps Up Play at Southern Regional Championships**

Dumitrescu posts tough loss in semi-finals to eventual winner; Clarke wins consolation singles bracket.

Tallahassee - The Florida State women's tennis team competed in the ITA Southern Regional Championships this past weekend in Athens, GA. The four-day event, hosted by the University of Georgia Bulldogs, is took place at the Dan Magill Tennis Complex.

In doubles-A bracket action, junior Mihaela Moldovan and senior Christina Denny made it to the third round before losing the tiebreaker 9-8(1) to Minor/Koppelle from Alabama. Senior Anca Dumitrescu and newcomer Roxanne Clarke also paired up but lost in the second round to Stephenson/Bentley from Alabama, 9-7.

In the singles-A bracket, Anca Dumitrescu reached the semi-finals after two incredibly hard-fought matches on Sunday. Dumitrescu defeated 15th seeded Robin Stevenson from Alabama 6-7 7-6 7-5 and 6th seeded Kelly Anderson of Georgia Tech 6-3 4-6 6-2 in back to back matches. The semi-final match-up against Florida's Jennifer Magley, Dumitrescu lost the first set 6-1 but battled back to 5-5 before dropping the match 7-5. Magley went on to defeat Georgias Shadisha Robinson in the final.

Mihaela Moldovan also had a successful tournament and reached the quarter-finals before losing to Katarina Palenikova of South Alabama, 6-4, 1-6, 6-3. Moldovan had defeated Florida's Boglarka Berecz 4-6 6-1 7-5 earlier in the day. Daniela Gheorghe lost in the first round to Miami's Staci Stevens, 6-0, 6-4 as did senior Christina Denny, who dropping the match to South Florida's Gabriela Duch 6-4, 6-1 in the first round. After losing in the first round to Karem Harboe from Ole Miss, 6-1, 6-2 newcomer Roxanne Clarke went on to win the A flight consolation in impressive fashion as she defeated the #2 players from Georgia Tech and the #1 player from Auburn in hard fought affairs.

"All in all, I am very pleased with our performance at Regionals. I felt we did a great job mentally and as a result were able to pull through in the tight matches." said Coach Gregory. "Our first tournament in Tuscaloosa was not as good as it could have been because we all played tight, but with a few catches under our belts it was a different story here."

The Noles next tournament is the USF Invitational taking place October 24-26 in Tampa, Fla.

### Magley Wins ITA Southern Regional

ATHENS---Georgia freshman Shadisha Robinson and Florida sophomore Jennifer Magley reached the singles final of the ITA Southern Regional Championships here Monday to earn bids to the ITA National Indoor event next month in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Magley will go in as the Southern Regional champion while Robinson was the runner-up. Robinson paired with senior Agata Cioroch to cruise to the Southern Regional doubles title and qualify for the nationals too.

Magley, the second seed, posted a 6-4,6-1 victory over the eighth-seeded Robinson in the singles final at the Dan Magill Tennis Complex.

Florida head coach Roland Thornqvist said Magley saved her best tennis for Monday.

"Jennifer played her best match of the tournament today in the final," said Thornqvist. "She had some great shots with her forehand and was very confident."

"The good thing is they both get to go to Michigan and overall as the eight seed, I was pleased to see Shadisha get to the final," said Georgia coach Jeff Wallace. "Hopefully today was a learning experience for her. She missed a lot of chances to finish points in the first set, and in the second set, she had some more opportunities and started to play better. She needs to play smarter in the big games and that will come with experience."



Against the Crimson Tide, both teams held serve for a 1-1 tie but then the Bulldogs won the next seven games for the victory. In the final, Georgia went up a break in the opening game and later broke the Bulls again for a 5-2 advantage en route to the win. This was the second tournament that Cioroch and Robinson have played in this year and now they have a chance to play in the second grand slam event of the season.

The first events -- the Rivera/ITA Women's and Icy Hot/ITA Men's All-American Championships -- were held earlier this month. The third event is the season-ending NCAA Championships in May with Georgia playing host for the women's event.





**ATHENS**—Four of the top 10 seeds advanced to the semifinals of the ITA Southern Regional Singles Championships here Saturday but the top seed was not one of them.

Georgia freshman Shadisha Robinson eliminated the tournament's top seed, Miami's Megan Bradley, winning 5-7, 6-3, 6-3 in the quarterfinals. Robinson, seeded eighth, will face 10th seed Katarina Palenikova (South Alabama) Monday while the other semifinal matchup features second seed Jennifer Magley (Florida) versus third seed Anca Dumitrescu (Florida State). Both semifinal matches will begin at 9 a.m. at the Dan Magill Tennis Complex. Admission is free.

In doubles, Robinson and senior Agata Cioroch, the top seeded duo, moved in to the semifinals with an 8-2 pro-set win over Florida's Berecez/Suvak. They will face an upstart Alabama duo of Melissa Minor and Nathalie Koppelle. The Crimson Tide duo advanced with a pair of wins that went to tiebreakers, the last coming over the seventh seeded FSU duo of Moldovan/Denny 9-8(1). The other semifinal will be Alabama's Stephenson/Bentley versus South Florida's Duch/Andrade. The times for these matches Monday have not been set because some of the players are involved in singles.

In the "B" draw, the singles final has Alabama's Mari Muller going up against Miami's Audrey Banada at 9 a.m. The doubles final will be the FSU team of Mihailescu/Tirapelli versus the Mississippi State duo of Serret/Rudman.





## ITA Southern Regionals, Day One

ATHENS - Today's action in the Intercollegiate Tennis Association Southern Women's Regional Championships saw fifteen of sixteen singles "A" draw top seeds winning their first round matches. The tournament's top seed, Miami's Megan Bradley won 7-5, 6-3 over Florida's Nina Suvak. Other standout winners amongst the top seeds included Florida's Jennifer Magley over South Florida's Maria Lord Andrade 6-2, 7-5; Florida State's Anca Dumitrescu over Florida International's Mei Ly 6-1, 6-1; Florida State's Mihaela Moldovan over Auburn's Martina Janska 6-0, 6-1.

The three Bulldog participants, all top seeds, defeated their opponents in round one of play. Natalie Frazier, the seventh seed, defeated Carolina Aravena of Troy State 6-0, 6-1. Shadisha Robinson, the eighth seed, defeated Andrea Kurekova of South Alabama 6-4, 6-2. Evgenia Subbotina, the twelve seed, battled South Alabama's Dominika Nemcovicova through three sets to get the win 6-4, 5-7, 6-3.

Round two of the singles "A" draw, originally scheduled to be completed today, was moved until Saturday morning due to rain.
