Florida State got some strong individual performances but didn't fare too well in the team standings as the Seminoles finished fourth at the Beeky Boone Relays in Richmond, Va. FSU finished behind the University of Illinois, Illinois State and Murray State in the final team standings. The Seminoles won the event last year.

Sharon Burgess, FSU's nationally ranked distance runner, successfully defended her own mile run title with a new meet record time of 5:13.5. Burgess contributed her usual double victory as she also took the half mile in a record time of 2:25.2.

Senior Joyce Dickins was the other Seminole winner as she won the 200-meter burdles and set a meet record with a time of 31.7. Dickinson also anchored the FSU 440 relay team that finished third. Other girls on that foursome were Susan Ray, Peggy Reed and Jeanette Brown.

Other Seminole points were scored by Reed with a third in the discus and a fourth in the shotput, Linda Churchfield with a fifth in the shot and Ray with a sixth in the discus.
