Florida Girls Cop Track Title

women's track team beat
Florida State and Tennessee Sunday in a threeway track meet.

The lady Gators amassed 67 points, Florida State 53 and Tennessee 38.

The event originally had been planned as the first annual Lady Gator Relays but three schools — Tuskeegee Institute, South Texas and Southeastern Texas — cancelled due to problems getting gasoline to get to Gainesville.

Leslie Smith led the Gators by winning both the 440 and 220-yard dashes and qualified for the nationals in each. Her time of 59.8 seconds in the 440 was the fastest that a Southeastern college girl has run the event.
