

## Mark set in 10,000 meter at Lady 'Nole Invitational

Leon High School graduate Lisa Kinch set a school record at 10,000 meters and Florida State's two-mile relay team qualified for the AIAW's national meet Friday on the first day of the Lady Seminole Invitational track meet at Mike Long Track.

Kinch won the 10,000 in 38:24.9 despite running the last half of the 6.2-mile race alone after teammate Lynda Heiman was slowed by an injury. Heiman held on to finish third in 39:47.7 behind Auburn's Tracy Gold.

Nancy McCormac got FSU a big lead in the opening leg of the two-mile relay, and the Lady Seminoles won easily in the AIAW-qualifying time of 9:12.8. Auburn was a distant second in 9:31.8.

Two other events were held on the opening day of the two-day meet. Auburn's Nora Araujo qualified for the AIAW while winning the pentathlon with 3,874 points. And Auburn's Gina Piatt won the discus.

A lot more track and field is on tap today at Mike Long Track, including what is expected to be a hotly contested 1,500 meter featuring FSU's McCormac and Leslie Sullivan. Today's field events begin at 4 p.m., with preliminary running events set for 5 p.m. Running finals are scheduled to begin at 5:30 p.m. There is no charge for the meet — which has drawn six college teams and athletes from two track clubs.

## Lady 'Noles take six wins

Host Florida State won six events, including a school record in the 3,000 meter, at the first Lady Seminole Invitational Saturday at Mike Long Track.

FSU's Kathy Moore ran a 10:01.6 to better the school record of Nancy McCormac in winning the 3,000 meters. Laura Ledbetter of the Florida State Track Club was second in 10:02.5.

The inaugural edition of the two-day meet drew athletes from six colleges and two clubs.

Florida State got much of its strength in the field events where the Lady Seminoles grabbed three victories. School record holder Nancy Townsend won the javelin with a toss of 144-4; Eleanor Majors threw a season-best 44-8 in the shot put; and Scoobie Golden long jumped 18-1 to defeat teammate Tonja Brown.

FSU's other victories came in the 800 meter and 100-meter hurdles.

Debbie Kemp ran a personal best by more than five seconds to win the

800 in 2:13.4. Florida A&M's Rose Oliver was second.

Brown, a freshman, won the hurdles in 14.6 seconds. She also came back to run a 56.5-second opening leg on the mile relay as FSU got second in the event behind Auburn.

The heralded 1,500 meter was won by former Florida State runner Bev Cox of Canada. She was pushed to a

4:32.8, well under the FSU record by prepster Nancy Buguey of the Falmouth-Perrier Track Club. Buguey ran a 4:36.2. FSU's Leslie Sullivan was third in 4:38.6, a season-best time.

Auburn sprinter Regina McBride set a Mike Long Track record in winning the 200-meter dash in 24.3 seconds.
