FSU dominates indoor meet

GAINESVILLE — The FSU women's track team took first in each event and improved its number of AIAW qualifiers to 11 Friday in the Lady Gator Indoor Meet.

The Lady Seminoles set six meet records and four school records in the non-scoring meet. Alice Bennett set a meet record in the long jump with a leap of 20-1½ and in the 400-meter run, Angela Wright set a meet and school record with a 55.4 clocking.

In the 600-meter run, Tonja Brown also set a school record with a time of 1:33.2 and in the 1,000-meter run, Margaret Coomber set a school and meet record with a 2:46.3 time. Gale Grant broke both marks in the 3,000-meter run with a time of 9:59.9.

Bennett, Coomber and Wright qualified for the indoor nationals which are scheduled for this weekend in Pocatello, Idaho.
