

Volleyball team extends win streak to 14 matches

LOUISVILLE, KY — The Florida State Lady Seminole volleyball team extended its win streak to 14 matches, defeating the Louisville Cardinals in three games by scores of 15-5, 15-10, 15-7 Friday night.

The win raises FSU's record to 17-2 and 3-0 in Metro Conference play. Louisville drops to 12-9 and 2-2 in Metro play.

The Lady Seminoles started quick with a .520 hitting percentage in the first game, and fell to a .095 in the third game.

The Cardinals were credited with 11 service errors. The Lady Seminoles had a total of 30 blocks, led by freshman Vicki Zinkil with nine block assists. It was the first match back in action for Zinkil after arthroscopic knee surgery last week.

The Lady Seminoles were led by Maggie Philgence with 13 kills in 18 attempts, with only one attack error for a .667 hitting percentage. Louisville was led by Laurie Maxwell with 12 kills.
