** Florida State has won its last seventeen matches that have stretched into five games. The win streak dates back to October 7, 1988 when the Lady Seminoles dropped a five-game contest to the University of Houston. FSU won its last eight five-game matches of the 1988 season and has won nine matches which stretched to five games this season.

** Florida State's come-from-behind win at Memphis State on October 25 gave 14th-year head coach Cecile Reynaud her 400th career victory. Her career slate currently stands at 408-163 for a .716 winning percentage.

During her tenure at FSU, the Lady Seminoles have won six of the last seven Metro Conference Tournaments including the last five. Florida State has seen action in five NCAA Championship Tournaments and reached its highest national finish in 1981 when the Lady Seminoles took fourth in the AIAW National Championship Tournament. Reynaud, the current president of the American Volleyball Coaches Association, has been named the Metro Conference Coach of the Year for the past two years.

** With Florida State's 30-5 record equalling an .857 winning percentage, it marks the best record in FSU history. The 1989 mark surpasses an .838 winning percentage recorded by the 1983 Lady Seminole team which finished with a 31-6 mark.

** Senior setter Nancy Gaspadarek ranks 12th on the NCAA all-time career assist list with 4,742. Gaspadarek, a three-time AVCA All-South region selection and FSU all-time assist leader, broke her own single-season assist record (1,216 in 1986) and currently has 1,348 assists in 1989. Also this season, Gaspadarek surpassed the career dig record and currently has 1,141.

** Fans continue to flock to Tully Gym at a rapid pace, according to 1989 attendance figures. In 18 matches, 11,577 fans passed through the gates to view Lady Seminole volleyball for an average of 643 per match. Five times in 1989, attendance figures topped the 1,000 mark. The season opener against Florida established a new record with 1,360 fans and against LSU, the attendance reached 1,056. During the Metro Conference Tournament, attendance twice topped the 1,000 mark.

Florida State setter Nancy Gaspadarek was selected the Most Valuable Player of the 1989 Metro Volleyball Tournament.

Gaspadarek collected 103 assists, 20 digs, 10 kills, eight blocks and a service ace as the Lady Seminoles swept to their fifth consecutive Metro crown, winning three matches in nine games.

The senior from Lansing, Ill., was named to the All-Metro and Metro All-Tournament squads in 1987, 1988 and 1989. She completes her career as the No. 1 setter in Florida State history with 4,843 assists, and also stands at the top of the all-time FSU dig list with 1,161.

Gaspadarek is pursuing a degree in psychology.
